### **Treasure Chest**

Can you make a treasure chest using an empty egg box? You could use it to do the maths treasure task on the Maths Grid.



#### **Musical Instrument**

Can you make your own musical instrument? You can use an empty container such as a plastic bottle or box and add items that will make a noise such as a few grains of rice, pasta, lentils etc. or of you do not want to use food items you can use items such as a botte tops, buttons, or stones found in your garden or yard. Then can you decorate it?

Can you make an alien character using a toilet roll tube and craft materials?
Can you think of a name for your alien?



### Rainbow

Can you make a rainbow collage using materials from around your house?
You could use items such as bottle tops, sweet wrappers, magazine cut outs etc.

Find 3 sticks from the garden or when you are out on your daily exercise walk. Use some string/wool or ribbon to tie them into a triangle shape. Now wrap more sting, wool or ribbon around the triangle structure. You can hang this in your house when it is



finished.
