Let's Celebrate

The aim of this curriculum map is to give you an insight into what your child will be learning about during this half term.

Autumn 2 Topic- Let's Celebrate

This half term we will be learning all about different celebrations. This will include celebrations your child may take part in but also about celebrations from around the world.

Personal Social Emotional Development

We will:

- *Learn about how we feel when we are preparing and waiting for a celebration.
- *Talk about how taking part in celebrations makes us feel.
- *Learn how we celebrate with others- sharing a celebration.
- *Continue to develop friendships, communicating and working together
- *Play alongside other children sharing our thoughts and ideas.

Communication and Language

We will:

- *Learn how to join in with small group discussions and whole class situations.
- *Recall and retell events from our own lives and stories.
- *Learn new vocabulary linked to celebrations- celebrate, festival, birthday, wedding, baptism, Hannukah etc.
- *To listen to and follow a series of instructions.

Physical Development

We will:

- * Develop our balancing skills using large equipment such as the Trim trail.
- *Use our bodies to move in different ways- to represent fireworks moving through the sky.
- *Follow a pattern or sequence of moves in response to music.
- *Develop fine motor skills for mark making including marks to represent name and numbers.
- *Continue to be independent when going to the toilet and washing hands.





Understanding the World

We will:

- *Learn about celebrations from around the world, where in the world we live and other countries around the world.
- *Talk about changes related to weather and seasons.
- *Look at artefacts and resources linked to celebrations and festivals- what do they mean and what are they for?
- *continue to develop positive attitudes about the differences between people and communities.

Mathematics

We will:

- *Continue to Identify and recite numbers 1-5 and 1-10 for children who are ready.
- *Learn number formation rhymes- writing numbers in the air.
- *Count objects with 1:1 correspondence, using touch and count technique.
- *Talk about patterns and shapes in the environment and linked to celebrations.



Literacy

We will:

- *Engage in conversations about stories and learn new vocabulary.
- *Learn about books- fiction and non-fiction. Naming different parts of the book- the front cover, blurb, pages. To know that we read from left to right.
- *Make marks on paper- give the marks meaning and draw with a purpose.
- *Interpreting marks and writing in the setting.
- *Pencil control for those who are ready



Expressive Arts and Design

We will:

- *Explore colours and how they can be changes.
Learn that materials can be manipulated and changed to create something else.
- *Learn songs related to celebrations.
- *Engage in small world play around celebrations.

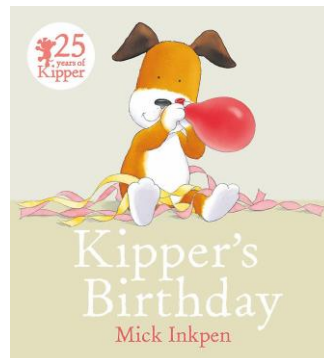
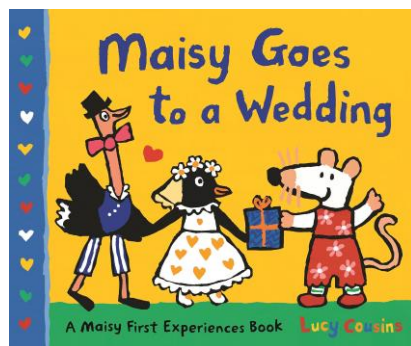
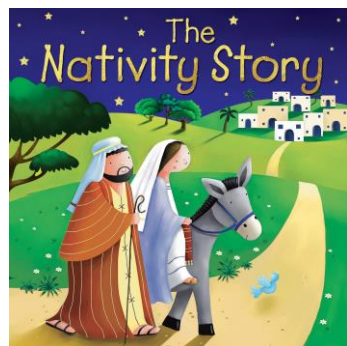
Your child is invited to all of the Christmas events even if it is not their usual day in Nursery- more information to follow.

Some of the stories we will be sharing this half term include:



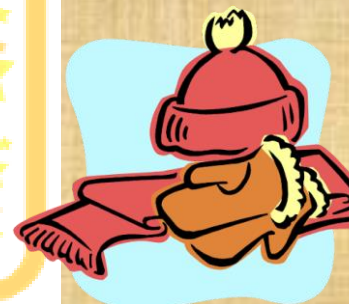
Cold weather
