Year One Curriculum Map

Autumn Second Half Term



Changes



Our topic this term is 'Changes'.

We will look closely at how we have changed as we have grown, and how toys have changed since the 1950s

English

- > In English we will be learning to write a simple retell of the fairytale 'Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs'.
- > We will also be learning how to write a set of instructions based on our DT project. This will involve preparing a healthy fruit salad for one of the dwarfs!
- We use the 'Talk for Write' approach to literacy whereby the children learn to retell a story using actions, then draw a story map consisting of pictures to tell the story, which finally helps them to write the story using phonic knowledge and simple punctuation (capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks, question marks).

Maths

In maths we will be working on addition and subtraction within 10. This includes using part whole models, investigating fact families for numbers to 10, and using number lines to count on and count back. An important part of our learning will be to know and use all the number bonds to 10:

0+10, 1+9, 2+8, 3+7, 4+6, 5+5, 6+4, 7+3, 8+2, 9+1, 10+0.

We will also be completing lots of problemsolving activities.

- We will be improving our ball skills - such as throwing, catching, chasing, rolling, bouncing.
- We will also learn how exercise affects our bodies.

Design and Technology (DT)

- Year 1 will be learning some basic cookery skills such as how to use simple utensils and how to wash, grate, peel, slice, squeeze fruit to make a fruit cocktail.
- We will also learn about healthy eating and the importance of fruit and vegetables.

PSHE

We will be discussing issues such

- What is in my local area?
- Why are our families important?
- Dental hygiene.

Computing

We will be learning to combine pictures and text to create a class book of the story 'Snow White'.

An important part of our ICT lessons will be to know that children should always ask an adult before using the internet.

History

- This half term we will learn about Guy Fawkes and The Gunpowder Plot and understand why we have Armistice Day.

Our focus will be looking at what Christians believe God is like.
