Spring First Half Term



To Our Area and Beyond

Our topic this term is 'To Our Area and Beyond'.

This includes learning about life in a castle and the history of Durham Castle.

English



This half term we will be retelling and innovating the story of

George and the Dragon by Chris Wormell.

As part of our learning on adjectives will be writing character descriptions by creating a wanted poster for a dragon! This will lead into how to write simple reports based on dragon from our imagination!

Our focus continues to be on using punctuation such as capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks. We are learning to consistently use capital letters for names within our writing and correctly spell a range of tricky words correctly. We will also be learning to spell words which end in 'ing' or have the prefix 'un'.

Our particular focus is to improve our handwriting by forming our letters correctly.

Maths



In maths we will be working with numbers up to 20. This will include counting, reading, writing, comparing and ordering numbers 11-20, as well as using a number line.

We will also be learning to partition numbers into tens and ones.

We will practise our adding and subtracting skills within 20, and we will learn about doubles and near doubles.

PSHCE



We will be discussing issues concerning charity, a balanced lifestyle and bullying.

Science



Throughout the year we are looking at seasons. This half term we are looking at the features of winter and asking:

- How does day length vary?

RE



Our RE unit is about 'Who is Jewish and how do they live?'

We will be learning about what is precious to Jewish people, some of the stories they tell from the Jewish Bible and how and why they celebrate the festival of Chanukah.

History



Do you know what the parts of a castle are called, or who lived and worked in a castle? Do you know who the Prince Bishops were? We will be finding the answers to these questions and much more!

Who was William the Conqueror and why did he order Durham Castle to be built in 1072?

Our topic is athletics

You will be amazed as we develop the ability to run at speed and develop our coordination and agility. Our reaction and response times will improve dramatically. Future Olympians will be made!

Computing



We will be using digital devices to take photographs. This will help us to be able to describe what makes a good photograph and how photographs can be improved. Maybe we will find some talented photographers in year 1!

As part of our ICT safety the children will learn about how someone else might feel before you post or share something online, and how you should always ask their permission first.

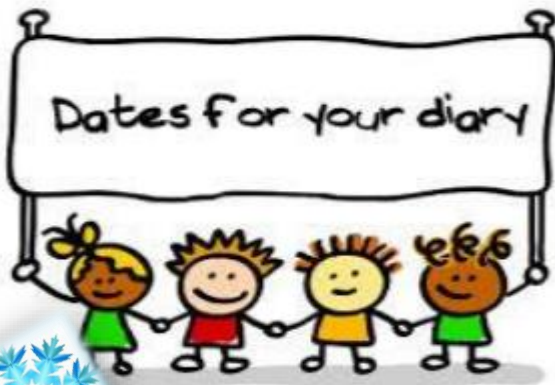
