

Year One Curriculum Map

Summer First Half Term



Let's Explore!

Our topic this term is Let's Explore!.

We will be learning about humans and exploring animals from equatorial and polar regions.

English

We will be writing our own version of

'The Tiger Who Came To Tea' by Judith Kerr.

We will be creating wanted posters to catch the tiger when he goes missing and writing our own version of the story to turn the tiger from a bad into a good character. Our focus will be to write sentences using the correct letter formation, finger spaces, capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks.

We will also be learning how to use the suffixes 'er' and 'est', and the prefix 'un'.

Maths

As part of our unit on multiplication and division we will revisit counting in 2's, 5's, 10's and making doubles.

We will also learn how to divide quantities into equal groups, and we will learn to make arrays to help us understand multiplication.

As part of our unit on fractions we will learn to make halves and quarters, find half or quarter of a shape or quantity.

As part of our geometry unit we will learn about half, quarter, three quarter turns.

We will also use the terms left, right, above, below, forwards, backwards etc to describe position.

Finally we will be using ordinal numbers eg 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc.

Art

We will be looking at how art can be made in different ways. This will involve exploring plaiting, knotting, and weaving techniques.

RE

We will be focussing on the question 'Who do Christians say made the world?' This will involve retelling the story of the creation and thinking about living in an amazing world.

SMSC

We will be discussing issues such as being proud to be British, stranger danger, loss and stereotypes.

Science

Humans and other animals

We will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.

We will identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

We will name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

We will learn to describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, including pets.

ICT

We will be learning to use simple algorithms when programming a beebot.

We will then discover whether the beebot followed the route we thought it would after we input our algorithm. If not we will need to debug the program.

As part of our internet safety lessons we will learn how to behave courteously and respectfully online.

Music

We will be learning to understand the difference between rhythm and pitch. We will also invent our own musical symbols to create pitch and rhythm patterns.

PE

We will be developing our gymnastic skills this half term. These will be led by an external gymnastics coach.
